ARTWORKS GRANTS 2026 – FAQs

1. How can I submit my application?

Applications must be submitted through ARTWORKS' website. Before applying, please make sure you meet the eligibility requirements and that your proposal aligns with the program's objectives.

2. When is the application deadline?

Applications must be submitted by May 17, 2026 (23:59 local time).

3. Can I submit more than one application?

Each candidate may submit only one application.

4. Can I apply as an individual?

The program is open for individuals who are mid-career artists or cultural professionals actively working in visual arts, dance, or curating and are embedded in the professional cultural landscape in Greece.

5. What is meant by mid-career?

Mid-career refers to practitioners who have at least seven years of professional experience and thus who have developed a significant body of work that has been showcased through participation in exhibitions, festivals, residencies and/or curatorial projects at a national and international level.

6. Are students eligible to apply?

The grants are intended for professionals who have completed their training and are actively engaged in their artistic field.

7. Can a project involve more than one person?

The application must be submitted by an eligible individual. The applicant should clearly state the role and responsibilities of each team member and reference all the creative collaborators in the proposal.

8. Can I submit required documents after the deadline?

All required materials must be included at the time of submission. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

9. Can I include video or image files with my application?

Yes, as long as the supporting materials are submitted through the designated sections of the online application form. Please ensure all files are clearly labeled and follow any specified file size and format requirements.

10. Do I need to submit bank or tax documents with the application?

Selected applicants will be asked to provide additional supporting documents at the final stage of the selection process.

11. What kinds of projects are eligible?

Projects that fall under the visual arts, dance (expanded choreography, movement research, dance/performative practices), or curating, which demonstrate a clear artistic vision, are feasible and well-planned, aim to connect with audiences, build institutional partnerships and/or expand internationally. The supported projects must be completed within 12 months after the grantees are notified about their selection.

12. Are grants awarded for residencies or educational

The program supports the creation and public presentation of artistic work, not participation in residency or study programs.

13. How much funding is available by discipline?

Funding varies by discipline:

- visual arts: six grants of €6.000/grant
- dance/choreography: two grants €8.000/grant
- curating visual arts exhibitions: two grants €8.000/grant

14. Can a project take place abroad?

Yes, as long as the applicant is based in Greece and the project aligns with the program's objectives of promoting Greek cultural production and international exchange.

15. Can I apply if I have other sources of funding for my project?

Yes. Applicants are encouraged to disclose any additional funding in their proposal.

16. Who selects the grantees?

A jury of distinguished professionals with experience across the supported disciplines will evaluate the proposals.

17. When will the results be announced?

Grantees will be notified individually by mid-July 2026.

18. What are the grantee's obligations?

Grantees are expected to carry out their project as proposed, submit one interim and one final report, participate in at least one public event organized by ARTWORKS, and acknowledge ARTWORKS' support in all promotional materials.
